IMPORTANT INFORMATION - SUMMER HOLIDAYS

From Tuesday 23rd July 2019, club hours will be reduced on Tuesdays and Thursdays for 4 weeks, i.e. 7.30pm to 9pm.

The reduced hours on Tuesdays and Thursdays will only affect swimmers who have lessons from 6.30pm to 7.30pm.

Swimmers who would normally have lessons between 6.30pm and 7.30pm should attend club from 7.30pm for their lesson **UNLESS YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER HAS ADVISED YOU A DIFFERENT TIME.**

Lessons from 8pm as normal.

There are no changes to lessons on Mondays and Fridays.

The decision has been made to reduce club hours for the 4 weeks of the Summer Holidays due to low attendance and loss-making in previous years.

Safeguarding

- All children 12 years and under must be accompanied into the building by a parent/guardian
- All children 12 years and under must have registered and paid for swimming before entry into the changing village

- Parent / guardian must ensure that the swimmer is on poolside for the start of their lesson and must remain within the building.

Attendance

- All members to arrive promptly for the start of their lesson.
- If your child(ren) is/are unable to attend lessons for any reason or do not wish to continue swimming at the club, it would be appreciated if you could advise the club by email – enquiries@brighouseswimmingclub.co.uk
- If any swimmer has not attended lessons for 4 weeks, without advising the club (email enquiries@brighouseswimmingclub.co.uk), we reserve the right to allocate their place to someone on the waiting list. Should the swimmer subsequently return to club, then we may have to place them on the waiting list

HEALTH & SAFETY OF MEMBERS

- During adverse weather conditions, please can you refer to the club's website.
- When entering the changing village / poolside, all outdoor footwear must be removed.
- All swimmers to shower before entering the water.
- All swimmers who require medication must ensure it is brought to every lesson otherwise your child(ren) will not be able to swim.
- Any swimmer who may have had an injection can attend lessons at their own discretion.
- Allergy Notice – some members have experienced a reaction to the use of shampoos containing nuts in the ingredients. We wish to make you aware, so you can consider others using the facility.
- Please discourage swimmers from walking in the reception area in swimwear.
- All personal belongings must be placed in a locker and not left in the changing village - £1 coin is required which is returnable.
- Spectators are not allowed at the changing village entrance to the teaching poolside
- Spectators to access changing village from teaching poolside via reception, please do not walk on poolside.
- Your child(ren) cannot enter the water if they have an eye, ear or throat infection, open/graze wound and weeping spots.
- If your child has just had their ears pierced, they cannot attend for one week and we accept that they will have to keep ear-rings in for an allocated time but once this time has passed then ear-rings must be removed before entering the water.
- All jewellery must be removed before entering the water.
- Parents, please could you ensure that children with long hair wear a swimming hat or have it tied back.
- Children in Level 3 groups or above to have goggles available for their lessons.
- Could parents please ensure that goggles fit correctly before your child(ren) enter(s) the water.
- For safety, all child spectators must be with an adult at all times.
- Child spectators in the main pool should not run on poolside or swing on the railings.
- The club recommends that members under the age of 16 years should not travel independently to the Pool.
- Members to be collected from reception, by parents/guardians, at the end of their lesson.
- We have been advised that chemicals used by the lifeguards when cleaning the changing room are not harmful when stepping through any area that has been cleaned or in the middle of a clean.
- Tuesday only – swimmers and parents for 8pm lessons, please wait in changing village until the aqua fit class has left the pool.
- Club t-shirts and swimming hats should be labelled with your child's name. Please use a permanent marker pen for the hats on the inside of the hat.
- Swimmers must wear t-shirt and shorts for photographs.
- Photography is strictly prohibited on poolside by any mobile device.
